## **Objectives of Team Finland Knowledge network**

- 1. Promote understanding of changes in higher education, research and innovation policy in the host country/region
- 2. Promote cooperation and partnerships
- 3. Make Finland more attractive to international talent



- **❖17** countries
- ❖Combined population ca. 400 million
- ❖ 67–46% of the population is under 25 y.o. (Cf. Finland 27%, EU 29,5%)

## TFK Pretoria – geographic and thematic focus

"Southern Africa" (Southern African Development Community SACD +Rwanda)

- Geographic focus on South Africa + countries where Finnish HEIs have partnerships / interests.
- Thematic focus from STI policies (regional, national, Finland, EU), and Finnish HEI interests. For example, in South Africa:
  - Engaging Finnish and SA HEIs in "Team Finland" themes: Critical raw materials and mining, digital transformation (esp. AI), water security and water in circular economy
  - Other key themes from embassy work: Higher education development; history and peace building – with innovation and inclusivity as crosscutting themes
  - AND YOUR THEMES <sup>(3)</sup>



- 70 publicly funded HEIs, numerous private institutions.

## **Current issues in higher education**

In the broad "Southern Africa" area covered by TFK

- Access. Ca. 4–6% of population with bachelor's degree, 1% with master's. Large youth cohorts > digital "solutions" and remote platforms needed
- Quality. Societal impact, worklife relevance (of HE degrees & of HE in lifelong learning in other sectors), decolonization
- Funding. Inadequacy of domestic government funding (max. 0,6% of GNP), dependency on foreign funding problematic, pressure and interest by HEIs for increased private sector funding.
- Networks. Great interest in collaboration with other African countries, South-South collaboration.

## Strengths in higher education

In the broad "Southern Africa" area covered by TFK

- Large youth cohorts. 67–46% of the population is under 25 y.o. (compare with Finland 27%, EU 29,5%)
- Diversity. Languages, contexts, views, actors
- Number of strong research universities (esp. in SA but please engage also with formerly disadvantaged HEIs)
- Panafrikanism and decolonial thinking.
- Strategic location for research. (Biodiversity, mineral wealth, social transformation processes, resource-scarce environments with potential for unexpected innovations)
- Internationalisation (incl. diasporas)

## When developing partnerships

#### Some ideas

- <u>UniPid ethical guidelines for responsible academic</u> partnerships with the Global South
- In identifying partners, consider:
  - Mutual interest
  - Time and resource constraints on both sides
  - Inequalities (formerly disadvantaged HEIs)
- In planning,
  - Responsiveness and active listening (do not assume ask and have a dialogue until there is a mutual understanding)
  - Who gets to move?
