# What strengths and challenges do you see/agree with?



#### **STRENGTHS**

- Past collabs > Relationships between colleagues
- Moving from "development" mindset to mutual interest as academics and HE administrators?
- Strong "selling points", incl. worklife relevancy
- New types of funding opportunities

#### **CHALLENGES**

- Guarding and making use of the core duties of higher education institutions (research, teaching, societal engagement ... academic freedom) in the context of new types of funding
- Scarce funding for collaborations is a clear challenge for education
   & science diplomacy

# Which measures could be taken to improve the situation?



- Identify and explore **new funding opportunities**, mindful of HEI core duties. Share experiences with others. **Nurture existing connections**.
- Drive to understand other stakeholders in multi-stakeholder initiatives.
- Keep on communicating the HEI perspective
  - Core duties
  - Academic freedom
  - Interests what is possible and meaningful for HEIs and what not?
  - HEI strengths ("package" existing partnerships to demonstrate quality and scale)
  - Concretise, concretise

# Not quite "New type of funding" but...

TF brings together all Finland's public internationalisation services.

Presence on the continent through Finnish embassies, who have identified certain key thematic areas.

Explore if alignment with **Team**Finland key areas is a possibility
(> networks, "real-world"
applications, some embassy
working time, publicity)



### Namibia (Angola):

Responsible mining, remewable energy and cleanteach, circular economy.

## Zambia (Malawi, Zimbabwe, Congo DRC):

Smart & sustainable mining- Circular economy -Forestry & other natural resources (water, meteorology, renewable energy)

South Africa (Botswana, Lesotho, Mauritius):

Water, mining and critical minerals, digitalisation.
Crosscutting: green solutions and innovation.

Tanzania (Rwanda Info to be shared later.

Mozambique (Eswatini, Madagascar): Education, energy, cleantech, infrastructure, mining, forestry

### "New types of funding" current examples



- <u>Rise to Challenge</u> by Business Finland. DL 31. October. A total of EUR 30 million for 5-10 projects. Finnish focus but could entail international collaborations.
- <u>Finnish Digital and Green Transformation (FDGT)</u> project secondments through HAUS. Secondment of digitalization experts from Finland to public sector organisations on the African continent. Max. 6 months. Should link to potential future business collaboration.
- <u>Joint Innovation Facility (JIF)</u>. EU funding, implemented by GIZ and Finnish HAUS.
   Amendable for private sector HEI collaboration. Especially female-led companies? Call opens early 2026.
- Global Gateway Africa embassies have their ears out for HEI opportunities (let me know if anything specific...)
