






WHAT IS THE GLOBAL PARTNERSHIP FOR EDUCATION?


DOING THE RIGHT THING

GPEs proven approach is:







FLEXIBLE FUNDING OPTIONS TO ADAPT TO COUNTRIES' CONTEXT





To strengthen planning and policy development, improve data and diagnostics, enable coordination and boost government capacity to learn and adapt.

PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT GRANT

To finance the design of an education initiative central to the government's priority education reform.

SYSTEM TRANSFORMATION GRANT

To support a priority reform that will catalyze far-reaching change across the education system.



To complement the system transformation grant to bolster initiatives to get girls learning.



To mobilize additional financing in support of education reforms (\$1 from GPE for every \$3 from external public sources, or \$1 from GPE for \$1 from private sector and philanthropic investments.)

TAKING INNOVATIVE FINANCING FURTHER



Partner countries need to shift from short-term, fragmented aid to long-term, sustainable investments anchored in domestic resources.

- Since 2018, GPE has mobilized \$4.7B in cofinancing through instruments like the Multiplier, Debt2Ed, GPE Match, Girls' Education Accelerator, and SmartEd.
- Backed by 70+ partners, including development banks, donors, and private/philanthropic actors.
- GPE 2030 aims to **scale our leverage to 1:5** and pilot new tools like **impact bonds** and **guarantees** to expand investment in education.





EXPANDING PRIVATE SECTOR AND FOUNDATIONS ENGAGEMENT



- •\$200M+ mobilized (2021-2025) through partnerships with 40+ private and philanthropic actors, including co-financing via the GPE Match and Multiplier.
- •Foundations took on **new leadership roles**, including as grant agents and coordinators in local education groups.
- •The new **Foundation for GPE in Geneva** expands collaboration with non-sovereign funders, supporting education, workforce readiness, and sustainable growth.





UKRAINE: INVESTING IN EDUCATION TO RESTORE HOPE



The conflict in Ukraine has disrupted learning for over 5 million children.

With GPE and partner support, a program trained 7,400+ teachers and reached 38,000 students with learning and psychosocial support.

Backed by \$25.5M from Google, Microsoft, and UNESCO, the initiative is expanding nationwide with 61,000+ teachers enrolled in online training and 39 new digital learning centers for displaced children.
