Steps for applying to the competition.

1. Complete the registration [form here](#).
2. In the registration email, you will receive the platform details and your login information.
3. Participating children need to finish all tasks for each book (reading, listening and taking the comprehension quiz).
4. Participants will be placed in one of the three different levels based on their grade. For more information, check this [User Guide](#).

There will be 20 winners chosen from each level! All 60 winners will receive a gift from the Children's Library. The first winner from each level will win a place in the Library's story writing workshop and Little Thinking Minds will publish their stories.

Then, click on the Student button.



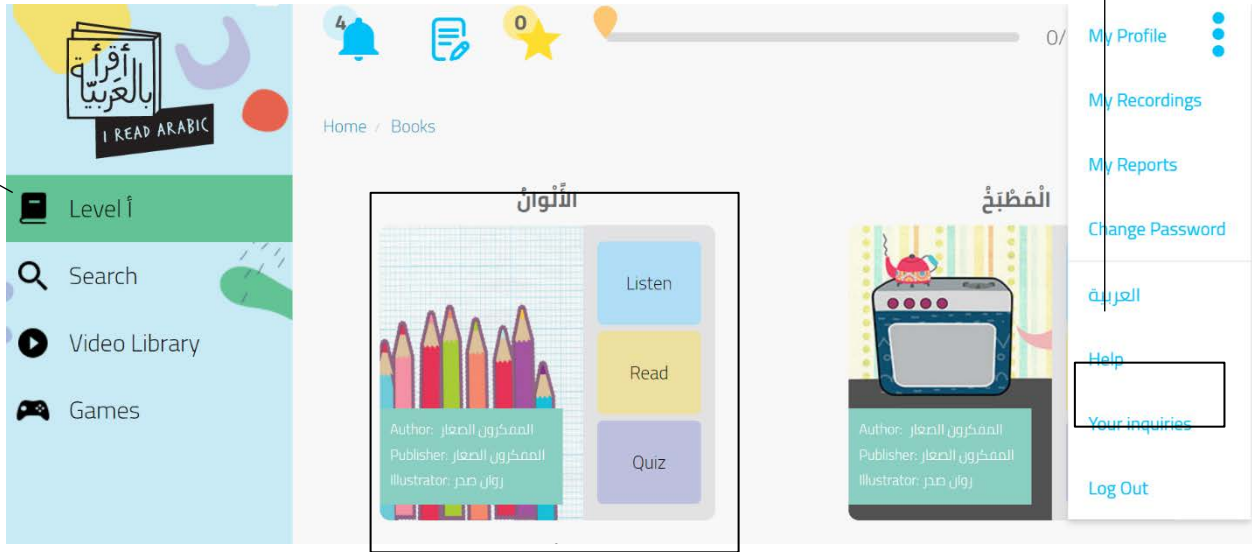
A holistic approach to Arabic language learning through a leveled reading program designed to advance the quality of Arabic language fluency and literacy.
