SOME HISTORY

Comparatively low amount of e-invoices

Public sector in the driving seat – Svefaktura since ~2005

Obligatory to send e-invoice to the public sector since April 2019

PDF via email still very popular

4-corner model

Operators and banks + PEPPOL - NEA & "Operatörssamverkan"

No public address database – No PDF attachments

Sticks, not carrots

Weak standards historically

3-corner model / EDI legacy

Complementing, not replacing PEPPOL



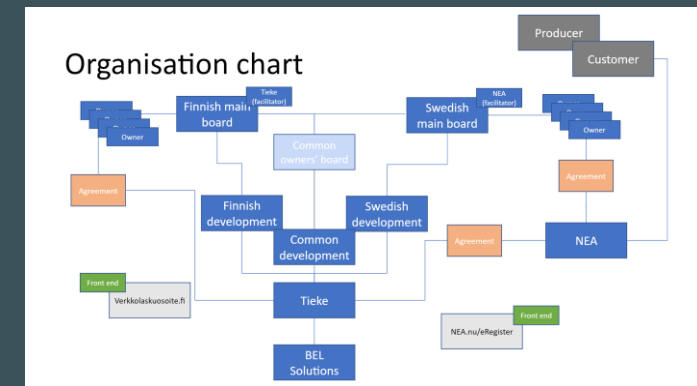
NEA E-REGISTER - DEVELOPMENT
